

NJUA Equal Employment Opportunity Scholarship



The New Jersey Utilities Association is offering two (2) four-year, \$1,500 per year scholarships (to be applied against tuition only) for minority, female or disabled students pursuing a Bachelor's Degree at an accredited college or university. Awards are applicable only towards tuition payments, not ancillary expenses.

This scholarship is being offered to all high school seniors who meet the following criteria:

- Currently a high school senior
- A resident of New Jersey and a legal resident or citizen of the United States with permission to work in this country
- A woman, a disabled person or a member of one of the following minority groups:
 - Hispanic or Latino
 - Black or African American
 - Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander
 - Asian
 - American Indian or Alaskan Native
 - Two or more races
- Have demonstrated overall academic excellence
- Can demonstrate financial need

All applicants are also responsible for ensuring that official copies of their high school transcript and two letters of recommendation are received at the address above by April 2, 2010.

Applications or documentation received after April 2, 2010 will not be considered.

Each award recipient must submit his/her parent or legal guardian's most recent year's tax filings prior to receiving any award money.

Each award recipient must submit an original letter from his/her college registrar's office as proof of enrollment prior to receiving any award money.

The NJUA EEO Scholarship is paid to the award recipients at the beginning of each semester (\$750.00 per semester). It is the responsibility of the student to request his/her award each semester. The funds will only be distributed upon receipt of proof of enrollment documentation from the student's registrar's office as well as the most recent semester grades. Failure to request payment or submit requested forms will result in the forfeiture of all subsequent funds.
